

CRITERIA FOR MEMBERSHIP TO THE SCIENTIFIC COMMITTEE

People who meet the following requirements may become members of the Iter Romanum Scientific Committee:

- Researchers and teachers specializing in Roman Archaeology who are affiliated with research centers, universities, foundations or other public or private entities whose objectives include research and training in this discipline.

- Experts and/or researchers in tourism, economics, geography, land-use planning and related disciplines, who are affiliated with research centers, universities, foundations or other public or private entities whose objectives include research, training and application of these disciplines

- Experienced, prestigious independent professionals involved in the project's subject matter and objectives.

• All members must demonstrate proven experience in research or specialized management.

> SELECTION PROCESS

- Presentation of the membership application addressed to the administration office of the Cooperation Network of the Heritage of Roman Roads (info@iter-romanum.eu). The application should include a letter expressing the reason for requesting membership and a CV highlighting contributions related to the Network's main themes and focus

- The Network's Scientific Committee will evaluate potential members, issue a justified report and select those they deem appropriate so that the Association's Board of Directors may then ratify their admission to the Committee. If considered pertinent, the Scientific Committee may make use of external advisors or evaluators.

- Once the candidate has become a member of the Scientific Committee, their CV will be published on the Association's website.



➢ FUNCTIONS

- Participate in those Committee meetings to which they are summoned.
- Advise the Network when requested by the Board of Directors
- Participate in the development of activity programs
- Advise the Network on the preparation of information and educational materials to ensure their accuracy.
