Professor of French Literature at the University of Toulon, works on the writing of history in the long 19th century and is particularly interested in the role of imaginary and ideological elaborations in the transmission and construction of cultural references, symbolic recompositions that shape the imagination of societies and power ideologies, and the selection of components destined to form the basis of a common culture, which she approaches from a decidedly transdisciplinary perspective.

She is notably the author of *Le roman de l'histoire* (L'Harmattan, 2001), *Penser la nation, mémoire et imaginaire en révolutions* (L'Harmattan, 2011), *Rome et l'histoire. Quand le mythe fait écran* (with Monique Clavel-Lévêque, 2017), *Jules Verne, un lanceur d'alerte dans le meilleur des mondes* (L'Harmattan, 2019), and, in 2023, *Le Rouge ou le Noir? Quand la fiction futurologique française prophétisait des lendemains qui (dé)chantent (1800-1975)* (Effigi).
