My professional activity has focused on the development and management of projects related to Cultural Heritage, especially archaeological heritage. I have led prominent research projects on the archaeological heritage of the city of Segovia, such as the study of the San Juan Gate of the medieval wall, the archaeological excavation of the Celtiberian wall, and the analysis of historical pathways linked to the Vía XXIV (Fuenfría Roman Road).

Currently, I am co-director of several research projects on the Roman world in the province of Segovia, including the Historic Quarries of Berrocal (Ortigosa del Monte), the Roman city of Confloenta (Duratón, Sepúlveda), and the villa of Santa Lucía (Aguilafuente).

Another area of expertise is urban planning development (catalogs and archaeological regulations of the PEAHIS, PGOU, and DALs of Segovia and around a hundred municipalities in Castilla y León and the Community of Madrid), and cultural projects related to the dissemination of cultural heritage (signage and creation of web content for several archaeological sites, cultural project of the Segovia Cathedral, archaeological guide of the Group of World Heritage Cities of Spain, and cultural project of the historical paths of Fuenfría).

During the period 2019-2022, I served as the Councilor for Urban Planning and Historical Heritage of the Segovia City Council, and in the period 2022-2023, I served as the Mayor of the city.
