Member of the Board of Directors of the Lusíadas Study Center (Cultural Unit of the University of Minho).

Held public positions as Councilor of the Braga City Council (2013-2021), with responsibility for heritage; planning and ordering; urbanism.

He was Vice-President of the Strategic Council for Patrimonial and Urban Regeneration of the Braga City Council (2019-2021).

He was President of the Association "Roman Routes Heritage in Europe - Cooperation Network (Iteromanum)" (2017-2021) and participated in the creation of the Network of Roman Cities of the Atlantic-ATLANTIACA, representing the Braga City Council (2019-2022)
