President of the *Parc Culturel du Biterrois* (since 2000), involved in the protection and promotion of heritage, she has notably co-directed excavations on the *Via Domitia* (*Colombiers and Nissan-lez-Ensérune, Hérault*).

She is an expert for the *Ministero dell'Università e della Ricerca*, MIUR (since 2013).

Member of the Scientific Committee of the *Narbo Via Museum* (*Narbonne*) since 2019 and of the *Via Domitia* project within the framework of the *Iter Vitis* France Network since 2023. Member of the editorial board of *Dialogues d'Histoire Ancienne*, published with the support of CNRS.

She was Director of URA 338/UPRESA 6048 of the CNRS/University of *Franche-Comté* (2000-1990). She was Vice-President of COST Action A 27 Understanding Pre-Industrial Structures in Rural and Mining Landscapes, LANDMARKS (2006-2002) and previously President of COST Action G2 Ancient Landscapes and Rural Structures: Techniques and Archaeo-environment, PASTA, European Commission (2002-1996).

Having long taught the history of the Roman world, she has dedicated her research mainly to various aspects of heritage and to methods of promoting it to a broad audience.
